



2009

Aurum RealEstate developed an ultra-luxury residential building in South Mumbai, 7 Marine Drive.

2014

Aurum acquired 7 million sq. ft. of a mixed-use project in Navi Mumbai from CapitaLand.

2015

Aurum launched top-tier commercial office spaces in Aurum Q Parc.

2016

Largest planned walk-to-work campus in the IT hub of Navi Mumbai.

2018

Delivered the first pre-certified LEED Platinum office buildings in Navi Mumbai.

Ascendas-Singbridge, a sovereign wealth fund in Singapore bought 1.4 million sq. ft. of commercial space in Q Parc for INR 930 crore.

2020

Delivered the LEED Platinum commercial building "Q2" in Navi Mumbai.

2021

Acquired Majesco Limited, which is now Aurum PropTech Limited, a publicly traded company listed with both major exchanges. Acquired controlling stake in multiple PropTech companies.

2022

Residential portfolio of Aurum Arts, Aurum Seven, Aurum Q Islands R4 to R7 across Mumbai Metropolitan Region is being developed.

Commercial and Retail projects of Aurum Q3 and Aurum Square in Navi Mumbai is under construction.

2023

Aurum acquired 14% stake in Shriram Properties from Walton St. Capital & Starwood Capital Group for INR 135 crore.

Aurum forayed into the redevelopment vertical with the acquisition of a residential society, Girnar (now Aurum Helios) in South Mumbai.
